Enjoy one wonder after another, including the awesome and powerful Niagara Falls as well as the unusual, but so popular Famous People Players. We have also included a baseball game between the Toronto Blue Jays and the New York Yankees. Call early, as this is sure to be a winner! You may have ventured to Niagara Falls previously, but this trip stays four nights in Niagara Falls, allowing you to explore and experience the best the region has to offer.



August 23 our journey begins as we pick up our fellow travelers, meet new friends and make our way to Elkhart, IN, for our first night.

August 24 after **breakfast** we make our way to the **Blue Water Area of Port Huron, MI**. Port Huron was selected in 2005 as an All-American city and continues to flourish as a hub of international culture with picturesque waterfront plans, thriving communities and abundant recreational opportunities. We will enjoy a **narrated, scenic boat cruise** along the Canadian and American shoreline while viewing the Great Lake and ocean-going freighters from the **Huron Lady II**.

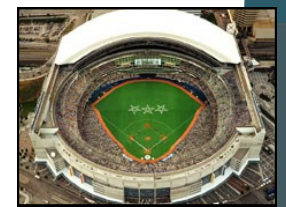


We'll also visit **Knowlton's Ice Museum**, with artifacts, ice tools, ice boxes, an actual ice wagon and over 3,000 other items used in the cutting, harvesting, storing, selling and use of natural ice. Before retiring to a newly renovated hotel for the evening, we'll enjoy **dinner** at the **Thomas Edison Inn** on the river.



August 25 following **breakfast** we will cross the U.S./Canada border on our way to **Toronto, ON**. What a classic day! Our first item on the agenda is the unique **Famous People Players Dinner and Show**, where we'll enjoy a great **lunch, fantastic entertainment** and the production is all prepared by 'special needs' individuals. Next we'll take a tour to the top of the **CN Tower**, still known as the tallest

free-standing structure in the world. The main observation decks afford panoramas of the entire Toronto area, and on a clear day, Niagara Falls and Buffalo, NY, are visible. The deck at 1,120 feet offers a view of the city through a glass floor, believed to be the highest glass floor in the world (what a feeling!!) And then, who should be in town but the **New York Yankees** playing the **Toronto Blue Jays** at the **Toronto Sky Dome**, with an all-weather retractable roof – and we'll have tickets! The Yankees have 26 World Championships and have won 39 American League Pennants (as of publish date!). After a full day, we load up and head south for **Niagara Falls, NY**, where we will stay at a favorite hotel the next **four nights**.

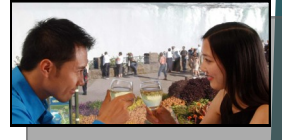


August 26-28 after a **breakfast each day**, we start our busy time in Niagara Falls. An **expert step-on guide** will join us to tour **Niagara Falls** and **Niagara-on-the-Lake** (a well-preserved town that was the first capital of Canada 1791-96, and presently a great place to shop in the quaint shops). Included in our activities will

be, of course, **the Falls** themselves, the **Maid of the Mist Boat Ride** (the boat takes you right up to the center of the mighty Horseshoe Falls – souvenir rain-coats are supplied), the **IMAX Movie**, “Niagara-Miracles, Myths and Magic,” the **Floral Clock**, the beautiful **Butterfly Conservatory** and much more. We’ve also included **dinner** in the **revolving dining room of the Skylon Tower** which overlooks the Falls, **lunch** at **Elements on the Falls**, “dining as close as you can get to the Falls.” We’ll also have **lunch** at the **Secret Garden** (a lovely restaurant located in the beautiful Oakes Garden across from the American Falls).



August 29 after another **breakfast**, we leave the beauty of the majestic fall and return to Elkhart, IN, for the night.

August 30 after **breakfast** we make our way back to our departure cities with many new friends and great memories.
